NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that the Shasta County Air Pollution Control Board will conduct a public hearing at 8:30 a.m., or as soon thereafter as may be heard, on Tuesday, June 4, 2024, in the Board of Supervisors Chambers located at 1450 Court Street, Room 263, Redding, California. The following item is set to be heard by the Board:

**PROPOSED SHASTA COUNTY AIR QUALITY MANAGEMENT DISTRICT
BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2024-25.**

The purpose is to review and receive public input regarding the Fiscal Year 2024-25 budget for the Shasta County Air Quality Management District (District). Members of the public are welcome to attend the hearing to offer comments on the proposed budget.

Copies of the proposed budget and any supporting documents, including, but not limited to, a schedule of fees to be imposed by the District to fund its programs, are available for public inspection at the District office located at 1855 Placer Street, Suite 101, Redding, California, and is open Monday through Friday 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., except County holidays. All proposed actions are subject to amendment or modification by the Air Pollution Control Board.

The formal adoption of the budget will occur at a separate meeting to be held at least two weeks after June 4, 2024.

ALL INTERESTED PARTIES are invited to submit written comments regarding the proposed budget prior to the hearing or participate in the public hearing.
