CALIFORNIA CERTIFIED PRODUCER'S CERTIFICATE Instructions for Completing Draft Application

- 1. NAME, ADDRESS, PHONE Complete with current information.
- 2. DBA (Doing Business As) Business Name. Leave blank if you do not use a business name.
- 3. PRODUCTION SITE(S) Location where crops you produce are grown. You may have more than one production site in the county.
- 4. STORAGE LOCATION(S) If you have stored your certified agricultural product, list location(s) and number of months in storage.

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- 5. SITE# Identify Production Site Number of each commodity. You may grow at more than one location.
- 6. COMMODITY Agricultural commodity produced. Examples: apples, grapes, honey, onions, peppers, squash, tomatoes, nursery stock.
- VARIETY/TYPE (of commodity) PLEASE BE SPECIFIC.
 Examples: Delicious apples; green or Torpedo onions; bell or hot peppers; zucchini or acorn squash; red, yellow, cherry, or Roma tomatoes.
- 8. AMOUNT/UNIT Planted area or amount for EACH variety or commodity. PLEASE BE SPECIFIC. Examples: .2 Acre; 1 50 ft. row; 2' X 10; 10 trees; 50 hens, etc.
- 9. HARVEST MONTHS Expected months of harvest. Examples: April – June.
- 10. EST PRODUCTION Estimated quantity of commodity to be sold at the **Certified** Farmers' Markets. (Not sales from your property or to stores.) Eggs usually sell by the dozen. Cut flowers usually sell by stem or bunch. Nursery stock sells by each plant (and requires a California Nursery Stock Certificate). Examples: 500 pounds, 100 gallons, 50 lugs.

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- 11. AUTHORIZED COUNTY List counties (other than Shasta County) where you intend to sell at a Certified Farmers' Market. Leave blank if you are selling <u>only</u> in Shasta County.
- 12. NAMES OF PRODUCERS If you will have a Certified Producer sell your product for you, list their name and CPC number. If you will sell product for another Certified Producer, list their name and CPC number. Documentation of agreement between partners is required. Both embossed certificates must be displayed simultaneously at market.
- 13. CERTIFIED PRODUCER'S SIGNATURE Please read statement and sign.

* <u>COPIES ISSUED (Official Use)</u> – Usually, one embossed copy per certificate. You are required to post the embossed copy when you are selling at a Certified Farmers' Market. If you plan to sell at more than one certified market at a time, you will need more than one embossed certificate. *Please inform agricultural staff how many embossed certificates you will need.*

 (U. S. Veterans' Exemption must provide DD-214 as proof of honorable discharge)
 \$5.00 - Each Amended Certificate, including veterans.
 (Original Certificate must be returned before amended Certificate can be issued.)

An original Certified Producer's Certificate will be prepared and signed by an Agricultural Investigator. This process may take several working days to complete. Your original signature will be required on the completed Certificate.
