### Gentlemen:

The following is a report of the condition, acreage, production and value of the agricultural products in Shasta County for the year 1968, submitted in accordance with Section 2279 of the California Agricultural Code. This report represents gross value of production and does not attempt to indicate net farm income or cost of production.

Generally favorable weather during the growing season gave near normal production rates which offset reduced acreages of some crops. The increase in total value is due to higher prices rather than greater volume. Successful experimental production of onions, beans, and garlic in Fall River Valley may bring about increased plantings in 1969.

A large increase in plantings of strawberry nursery stock was nearly destroyed by rain and snow during the harvest season. I estimate that approximately 150 acres were completely lost.

Direct questionnaires to producers have been used in compiling this report. We sincerely appreciate the excellent response and the assistance we have received from the University of California Extension Service and from other agencies and individuals.
