LADIES AND GENTLEMEN:

THIS IS A REPORT OF THE CONDITION, ACREAGE, PRODUCTION, AND VALUE OF AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTS IN SHASTA COUNTY FOR THE YEAR 1979, SUBMITTED AS REQUIRED BY SECTION 2279 OF THE CALIFORNIA FOOD AND AGRICULTURE CODE. THIS REPORT REPRESENTS THE GROSS VALUE OF PRODUCTION AND DOES NOT ATTEMPT TO SHOW COUNTY INVENTORY, NET FARM INCOME, OR COST OF PRODUCTION.

AGRICULTURAL COMMODITY PRICES GENERALLY POSTED BIG GAINS IN 1979. THE BIGGEST GAINS WERE IN ALFALFA, LIVESTOCK, NURSERY STOCK, AND WHEAT. PRICE DECLINES WERE SEEN IN THE OAT AND WALNUT MARKETS. RECREATION HORSES SHOWED A PRICE INCREASE THAT DID NOT INCLUDE THE IMPORTANT BREEDING STOCK MARKET. AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTION IN 1979 SHOWED SOME MIXED RESULTS BECAUSE OF VARYING CLIMATIC CONDITIONS. STRAWBERRY NURSERY STOCK SHOWED AN INCREASE IN YIELD PER ACRE DUE TO FAVORABLE GROWING CONDITIONS BUT UNFAVORABLE WEATHER AT HARVEST TIME CAUSED A SEVERE REDUCTION IN HARVESTED ACRES. THOSE COMMODITIES THAT SHOWED A SIGNIFICANT INCREASE IN TOTAL PRODUCTION WERE APPLES, GRAIN, LIVESTOCK, OLIVES AND PACKAGE BEES.

INFLATION CONTRIBUTED GREATLY TO INCREASED PRODUCTION AND OVERHEAD EXPENSES THAT WERE PASSED TO CONSUMERS IN THE FORM OF INCREASED COMMODITY PRICES. THESE INCREASED COMMODITY PRICES AND GENERALLY FAVORABLE GROWING CONDITIONS ALLOWED SHASTA COUNTY PRODUCTION IN 1979 TO KEEP UP WITH INFLATION RATES.

INFORMATION FOR COMPILING THIS REPORT HAS BEEN OBTAINED FROM PRODUCERS, GOVERNMENT AGENCIES, REPRESENTATIVES OF AGRICULTURAL BUSINESS, AND INDIVIDUALS WHO HAVE SPECIAL KNOWLEDGE IN THEIR FIELD. THE COOPERATIVE ASSISTANCE WE HAVE RECEIVED FROM THEM IS SINCERELY APPRECIATED. THE COMPILATION OF THIS REPORT WAS UNDER THE DIRECTION OF INVESTIGATOR RICHARD PRICE.
