Since the passing of Prop 64 in November of 2016, commercial cannabis production throughout California has steadily increased. While cultivation of cannabis for personal and medicinal use is allowed in the unincorporated areas of Shasta County, growing commercial cannabis for resale is illegal. With proper licensing, the City of Redding and the City of Shasta Lake allow businesses to grow and sell indoor grown Cannabis. In 2021, there were 39 active licenses registered with the California Bureau of Cannabis Controls. According to information provided by the two cities allowing indoor grow operations, there was approximately 97,027 square feet of indoor production taking place within Shasta County in 2021.
