RESOLUTION APPROVING PETITION FOR FORMATION OF
BUCKEYE COUNTY WATER DISTRICT, FIXING THE BOUNDARIES
THEREOF AND CALLING AN ELECTION ON JANUARY 9TH, 1951,
TO DETERMINE WHETHER SUCH DISTRICT SHALL BE FORMED
AND FOR THE ELECTION OF THE FIRST BOARD OF DIRECTORS.

WHEREAS a petition signed by voters within the following described proposed Water District in excess of ten per cent of the number of votes cast in the proposed district for the office of Governor at the general election next prior to the presenting of said petition was filed by said voters was filed with the Board of Supervisors of Shasta County on November 1, 1950, and said petition prayed that the territory therein described be incorporated into a water district pursuant to the County Water District Law, and

WHEREAS said proposed district constitutes a portion of the unincorporated territory of Shasta County and has a population in excess of three hundred inhabitants, and

WHEREAS said petition described the boundaries of said proposed district as in this resolution hereinafter described, and

WHEREAS no municipal corporation, or any portion thereof, is included in the proposed district, and

WHEREAS the County Clerk of the County of Shasta published a notice of hearing on the said formation petition once a week for at least two weeks in the Redding Record and Searchlight and the Courier Free Press, a newspaper of general circulation printed and published in Shasta County, and

WHEREAS an affidavit of such publication is on file in the office of said County Clerk and has been presented in evidence at this hearing, and

WHEREAS said notice contained the following information, to wit: 1) the text of said petition for formation of said water district; 2) the number of signers of the petition; 3) at least five of the names signed to the petition; 4) the date and time and place of the meeting of the Board of Supervisors of Shasta County at which the petition will be presented and considered; 5) a statement that all persons interested may then appear and be heard, and

WHEREAS the date set for such hearing was November 17, 1950, at the hour of 2:00 o'clock P.M.; and

WHEREAS said petition has been presented to the said Board of Supervisors and considered by it and evidence in support thereof has been offered and received, and

WHEREAS no evidence against said petition has been offered and no one has protested either orally or in writing against said petition,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, FOUND AND DETERMINED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF SHASTA, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, AS FOLLOWS; TO WIT:

1. That all of the foregoing recitals are true and correct;
2. That the description of the proposed boundaries of said proposed district as contained in said petition is as follows, to wit:

Beginning at the West 1/4 corner of Section 23, T. 32 N.R. 5 W., MD.M, which point is the SW corner of said district and running thence Easterly along the mid-section line of Section 23 to the East 1/4 corner of Section 23 thence Southerly along

19 to a point from whence the Easterly 1/4 corner of Section 19, bears S. 00°57'25" E., 2,115.91 feet; thence N. 77° 02'12" E. 493.11 feet; thence N. 18°37'48" W., 200.98 feet to a point; thence S. 77°02'12"W430.73 feet to a point on the Easterly line of Section 19; thence continuing Northerly along the Easterly section line of Section 19 to the NE corner of Section 19, thence Westerly on and along the Northerly line of Section 19, to the North 1/4 corner of Section 19; thence Northerly along the mid section line of Section 18 to the North 1/4 corner of Section 18; thence Westerly along the North line of Section 18 to the SE corner of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 7, thence Northerly and Westerly on and along the East and North lines of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 7, to the NW corner of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 7, thence Southerly on and along the West line of Section 7, to the SE corner of Section 12, T. 32 N., R. 5 W. thence Westerly along the Southerly line of Section 12 to the South 1/4 corner of Section 12; thence Northerly along the mid section line of Section 12 and Section 1 to the North 1/4 corner of Section 1, thence Westerly along the North line of Section 1 to the NW corner of Section 1; thence South along the West section line of Section 1 to the Southwest corner of Section 1; thence West along the North line of Section 11 to the Northwest corner of Section 11; thence Southerly along the West line of Section 11, 14 and 23 to the point of beginning.

The above described property contains the W $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 1 and the W $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 12, all of Sections 11, 13, 14 and 24 and the North 1/2 of Section 23, T. 32 N., R. 5 W., and Section 19, the West 1/2 of Section 18 plus a small 2.12 acre tract in the Northwest 1/4 of Section 20 and the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 7, T. 32 N. R. 4 W., M.D.M.,

3. That said petition for the formation of a water district complies in all respects with the County Water District Law as set forth in the Water Code of California.

4. That no changes in the proposed boundaries of said proposed district are hereby finally determined to be as set forth in paragraph 2 hereinabove.

5. That said petition is genuine and sufficient and in all respects complies with the law.

6. That said proposed district shall be known as the Buckeye County Water District.

7. That an election is hereby called and ordered to be held on January 9, 1951, in said district for the purpose of determining whether or not said district shall be formed.

8. The election hereby called shall be conducted and held and the vote thereat received and canvassed and the returns made in accordance with the provisions of the County Water District Law of California.

9. For the conduct of said election the said Buckeye County Water District, as hereinabove approved shall constitute one election precinct numbered One. The voting precinct, polling place and election officers duly designated and appointed are as follows:

Election Precinct No. One. shall include all of those portions of the Buckeye, Dryden, Hammans, and River precincts situate within the above described boundaries of said Buckeye County Water District.

Polling Place: Buckeye School House

Election Officers:

Inspector: Marian B. Thorpe

Judge: Katherine M. Hiatt

Clerk: Delilah Coryell

The polls at said election shall be open between the hours of 12:00 noon and 7:00 p. m. when said polls will be closed (except as provided in Sections 5734 and 5735 of the Election Code) and the election officers will thereupon proceed to canvass the votes cast thereat. The number of the first Board of Directors of said proposed district will likewise be voted on and for at said election and pursuant to the provisions of the County Water District Law.

A committee of six appear before the Board and request that gravel be placed on the Ditch Grade road from Igo to Platina.



1.
