ZOGG FIRE DEBRIS REMOVAL OPTIONS AND WARNING

(Rev: 01-03-23)

Your parcel may be eligible for disposal of Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) and fire debris removal, at no direct cost to you, through the State of California's Fire Debris Removal Program. Participation in the State Fire Debris Removal Program is encouraged, but not required. If you do not wish to participate in the State Fire Debris Removal Program, you may obtain a Demolition Permit under the County's Zogg Fire Debris Removal Program and remove fire debris yourself in accordance with permit requirements and Environmental Health Standards.

IF YOU OBTAIN A DEMOLITION PERMIT UNDER THE COUNTY'S ZOGG FIRE DEBRIS REMOVAL PROGRAM OR REMOVE FIRE DEBRIS OR DISTURB THE ASH FOOTPRINT ON YOUR PARCEL, YOU WILL NOT BE ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE STATE OR FEDERAL FIRE DEBRIS REMOVAL ASSISTANCE.

Therefore, if you want your parcel to be eligible for State or Federal-facilitated fire debris and HHW disposal, DO NOT obtain a Demolition Permit and DO NOT REMOVE HHW OR FIRE DEBRIS FROM YOUR PROPERTY. Failure to heed this warning will result in your parcel being ineligible for any State or Federal assistance.

The State's Fire Debris Removal Program will include two phases. Phase 1 must be completed in order for your parcel to participate in Phase 2.

Phase 1: Removal of household hazardous waste (HHW) by the California Department of Toxic Substances Control (this Phase is also known as the HHW "Sweep"); and

Phase 2: Removal of fire waste and debris from the ash footprint, including removal of foundations by the State.

If a Demolition Permit is issued to you, or you start to remove fire debris or disturb the ash footprint before Phase 1 is completed on your parcel, then you will be ineligible for Phase 1 and Phase 2 fire debris removal assistance under the State Program. Similarly, if you remove fire debris or disturb the ash footprint after Phase 1 is completed on your parcel, then you will be ineligible for Phase 2 fire debris removal assistance.

Please also be advised that the sale of your parcel may render your parcel ineligible for any State or Federal HHW or fire debris removal assistance.

If you obtain a Demolition Permit, you must comply with all applicable standards for disposal of HHW and fire debris issued by the County of Shasta.

ASH & DEBRIS MAY BE HOT AND CONTAIN HAZARDOUS MATERIALS. USE APPROPRIATE RESPIRATORY PROTECTION, GLOVES, DISPOSABLE COVERALLS, FOOTWARE, GOGGLES & HARDHAT. IF YOU PROCEED WITH OBTAINING A DEMOLITION PERMIT AND THE REMOVAL OF YOUR FIRE DEBRIS, YOU DO SO AT YOUR OWN RISK. DO NOT DISTURB ASH WITH LEAF BLOWERS. ASH SHOULD BE WETTED TO PREVENT AIRBORNE EMISSIONS, BUT SHOULD NOT BE SATURATED TO THE POINT OF RUNOFF.
