BEHAVIORAL HEALTH TEAM

The Behavioral Health Team offers free and confidential services for individuals dealing with alcohol and/or drug abuse, mental health and domestic violence-related problems.

The Behavioral Health Team is a service of the Shasta County Health and Human Services Agency.

CALWORKS EMPLOYMENT SERVICES

Your participation with Shasta County's Behavioral Health Team may count toward work activities in the Welfare-to-Work program.

The Behavioral Health Team is committed to helping reduce barriers to employment caused by stress, grief, depression, emotional problems, alcohol and/or drug abuse, domestic violence, mental health, relationship issues and other pressures of daily life.

If you are receiving services from any of the following types of programs, your hours may count toward your CalWORKs work activities.

- Mental health
- Anger management
- Family violence
- Alcohol/drug treatment

SERVICES

- Assessment of any barriers toward employment
- Counseling for stress, grief, substance abuse and other behavioral health issues
- Support groups for individuals with behavioral health issues
- Advocacy for you in your efforts to regain or retain employment
- Therapy for behavioral health issues
- Referrals to other helpful programs or resources

ELIGIBILITY

Anyone who has applied for aid and is currently on CalWORKs, may be eligible for behavioral health services. Anyone participating in the Welfare-to-Work program has access to behavioral health services.

The Behavioral Health Team is committed to helping you; believing that each step forward is a positive step that may lead to reducing the suffering caused by alcohol and drug abuse, stopping the cycle of domestic violence, and coping with mental illness and/or emotional problems.
