Did you know that lead can be found in the dust and dirt in and around your home? A child poisoned by lead can develop learning disabilities and speech delays, even if they don't appear sick. Washing your child's hands before eating and sleeping, and washing your child's toys often, can decrease the amount of lead your child puts in their mouth. As a bonus, hand washing and keeping toys clean can decrease your child's exposure to cold and flu germs!

To make sure hands get "squeaky clean," wash with soap and water for 20 seconds while singing "Twinkle, Twinkle, Little Star" or the "ABC" song, and scrub between fingers, on the backs of hands, and under the fingernails too!
