WHAT IS WORK EXPERIENCE?

- Provides participants who have been out of the workforce, an opportunity to gain employment references
- Assists participants with employment to enhance their employability upon completion
- Helps participants, who are looking for a change in their career, to develop new skills
- Provides participants with job skills and an opportunity to develop good work habits and positive attitudes

BENEFITS FOR EMPLOYER:

- Gain additional staff for your business at no cost to you
- Worker's Compensation is provided by the State of California
- The opportunity to evaluate participants as potential employees with no obligation to hire
- Eligible for the Work Opportunity Tax Credit program, if you hire the participant
- Strengthen the local economy by supporting programs that put people back to work

THINGS TO KEEP IN MIND:

- Participants may enter or exit the program with minimal to no notice
- Some participants may be struggling with certain barriers
- For some, this may be their first experience in a workplace setting

BENEFITS FOR PARTICIPANTS:

- Gain exposure to potential employers
- An opportunity to learn new skills, experience career paths, network and strengthen their résumé

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

Q: Does CalWORKs drug test or do background checks?

A: No, we leave it up to each individual business to allow our participants to follow the same guidelines as regular employees.

Q: How long will the participant volunteer?

A: The length of time varies for each individual participant.

Q: How many hours per week can a participant volunteer?

A: Participants are required to participate in WEX anywhere between 5 to 35 hours per week.
