What can Prenatal Care Guidance (PCG) do for me?

A nurse from the PCG program can help you to:

- Connect to Medi-Cal or other low-cost insurance
- Get prenatal care even if:
 - -You do not have Medi-Cal or insurance
 - -You are undocumented
 - -Your Medi-Cal is pending
- Find a doctor to care for you and your baby and make an appointment
- Get additional help, such as food, transportation and housing
- Find other social support and health and family planning services
- Get help from programs for pregnant teens

- Don't use drugs or medication unless your doctor says it's ok
- Don't smoke cigarettes
- Stay out of smoky places
- Eat healthy foods and take prenatal vitamins
- Get regular dental care
- Exercise daily
