

WHERE CAN I GET MY YEARLY FLU SHOT?

Flu shots are recommended for anyone over 6 months of age to help prevent serious illness and health complications. Shasta County will provide free flu shots to all Shasta County residents - regardless of insurance status. Visit ShastaFluShots.com for more information.

Below are some of the ways you can get a flu shot (some providers may not give flu shots to all ages):

- 1. From your Primary Care Provider
- 2. From local pharmacies, including:
 - a. Walgreens
 - b. Rite Aid
 - c.Costco
 - d.Safeway
 - e.CVS
- 3. At the Public Health clinic, by appointment
