Drive-Thru Flu Clinic this Saturday

SHASTA COUNTY – Shasta County will provide free standard flu shots during its annual drivethru flu clinic.

Saturday, October 16, 2021 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. 2650 Breslauer Way, Redding

Flu vaccines cause antibodies to develop in the body about two weeks after vaccination. These antibodies protect the body against infection. Because it can take this long for the flu shot to work fully, the Centers for Disease Control recommends getting your annual flu shot by the end of October.

Flu shots are also provided by health care providers and many retail pharmacies. If you are unable to get your vaccination through your medical provider or unable to visit the drive-thru clinic, you can still get a free flu shot at the Shasta County Public Health Clinic.
