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FUNDING FOR ALZHEIMER'S AND DEMENTIA: Community input shapes local Alzheimer's and dementia services

SHASTA COUNTY—Shasta County Health and Human Services Agency (HHSA) requests the public's help to measure the impact Alzheimer's and dementia have in our community. By filling out one of the short surveys below, you can inform programming that benefits people with Alzheimer's and dementia, their caregivers, and the first responders who help them in emergencies.

Shasta County has the highest death rate of Alzheimer's in the state, according to the 2020 County Health Status Profiles. As such, Shasta County was one of six local health jurisdictions that received funding to increase awareness and support for those impacted by dementia.
