These record seals may come from other places such as:

Other counties will send us a copy of their court's sealing for us to use in sealing whatever records we may have of him/her.

Our Public Defender's office may send us record seals on minors that have successfully terminated from probation. For the sake of continuity, we are sealing all the cases which are listed on the seal document and any old cases such as misdemeanor cases handled informally, SARB cases or JCWP cases. (In 2015) I met with the Public Defender (Peggy Huscher) and Court Clerk (Colleen Heffner) and it was decided that would be our practice from now on. The PD office will write the case number and petition numbers and add "et al" to encompass all cases under the defendant's name.

Or the JV596 gets returned to us from court after they get signed and certified. The files are sealed and stored here until the stated destroy date on the JV596.

Procedure to Seal

Pull up minor's case.

Make copy of record seal and mail the original to the defendant. (Make out envelope prior to sealing the record or you will smack your hand against your forehead for not thinking of it.... \odot)

Scan filed and certified record seal into the original probation case for minor.

F11 from defendant's menu

F10 to add document

Name it Record Seal and type the date it was sealed, place document face down in scanner, enter, click "scan"

Press enter once the document has been scanned

F12

Delete all ticklers from minor's cases.

Ensure that all programs are closed out; none left open without completion code.

Program closing list:

File the copy of the record seal in the court document section on top of the Court Notes in the green file.

Select #4 – events from minor's original case

After reaching age 18, persons who have acquired records as juveniles are permitted to petition the Juvenile Court to have those records "sealed". (Anyone terminated after January 1, 2015, can be sealed if they have terminated successfully or had their charges dismissed in court. Our office files a JV596 sealing document with the courts to seal their record.) The following instructions refer to a defendant terminating <u>prior</u> to January 1, 2015.

If the Court "seals" the records, the effect is that all arrests, court documents and probation reports, etc. are deemed to have not occurred. The person may lawfully answer "no" to any questions that may be asked of him or her, such as: were you ever arrested, prosecuted, etc. as a juvenile.

A person who has been found by the Juvenile Court to have committed a "serious felony" (as defined in Welfare and Institutions Code 707(b)) may not have his/her records "sealed". To save everyone time, please look up the person in the computer prior to them paying to see if they are disqualified due to serious juvenile charge or active adult cases.

The reception clerk will give the client the form entitled, "Instructions to Minors Concerning Sealing Juvenile Court Records", and a Juvenile Record Seal Application. The clerk will instruct the client that upon deciding to apply, he/she needs to complete the application and pay \$150.00 processing fee (For Felony Conviction) or \$60.00 (For Misdemeanor Conviction). A receipt for payment must be made out to the applicant (white=applicant, yellow=accounting, pink copy stays in the receipt book).

- 1. Once application and receipt of payment of fees are received, the assigned clerk will:

 Print and Fill out a "Record Seal Face Sheet" (Found in the Record Seal portion of the clerical manual)
 with the client's name and the current date. The sheet will be kept on top of the application packet. This sheet contains all the steps and information needed for quick reference as to the status of the record seal process.
- 2. Put a check mark by Fee Pd: to indicate receipt of the \$60.00 or \$150.00 fee. Note: Processing may not proceed any further if the fee has not been paid.
- 3. Run a previous records report:

Booking sheets arrive via our printer in the clerical file room. Use the current roster which is emailed from JRF daily.

- Ensure that you have a booking sheet for each person highlighted on the Roster (If not, call JRF Control for assistance #5824)
- Look up minor's name in computer
- Determine correct assigned officer
 - o Currently supervised minors will have a PO assigned
 - o Brand new minors will be assigned according to the intake scheduled officer; if charge is misd, check with officer to see if they are going to keep the minor or give to PO082.
 - Warrant bookings belong to latest PO listed in the "Witness" section of the minor's case, these will be calendared for next day court in most circumstances, but we do have 48 hrs
 - Booking sheets belonging to <u>new</u> minors that have been DRAI'd out of hall will go to referral clerk to process and be placed on the 82 caseload for misd and 99 caseload for felonies
- Ensure that booking is entered correctly
 - o Every new offense requires a new case be initiated by the hall
 - Warrant bookings are entered in the case where the Warrant initially issued (Use WJ tickler to locate appropriate case)
 - Courtesy Supervision for another county will normally be handled by the PO supervisors in the hall as far as arranging transportation back to their county; we do not need to do any data entry at this point.
 - o Transfers In from another county for either disposition or wardship will have two packets in manila envelopes that came with them, one is ours, and one is for court clerk. These will need to be scheduled for court w/in 48 hours. These are to go to the clerk doing transfers for immediate processing. These can be tricky, a new transfer in for dispo will need their own new case in Jalan, a minor being transferred BACK to us from us having transferred them out, will be booked into the same case. Ensure that the hall did this correctly. A minor being transferred in for Wardship, never having been here before, will also have a new case entered.

Court Run

OVERVIEW

Paperwork between the Courts and Probation must be transported timely to ensure all parties receive needed documentation to process offenders and facilitate court hearings. Each clerk is responsible for one day per week. The court run typically is made at 10:30 a.m. every day.

PROCEDURE

- 1. Collect documents from Probation
 - a. Collect any reports, petitions and Work Program paperwork from the Court Run tray at 1600 court Street, 1st Floor
 - b. Group paperwork
 - i. Group together all in-custody petitions and place on top of the pile
 1. In-custody petitions will all have today's date with a 1:30 time
 - ii. Group together all other petitions and place second in the pile
 - iii. Group together all other reports and place third in the pile
 - iv. Department land 2's reports will already be packed in their respective folders. Place folder on bottom of pile.
 - c. Collect all documents for the District Attorney
 - Collect any items from the DA (District Attorney) tray which is next to the Court Run tray. Put DA mail in a county manila envelope – write "DA" on front of envelope.
 - d. Put all petitions, reports, DA mail and Work Program paperwork in a black or blue folder. This folder goes on top of Department 1 and Department 2's folders.

2. Court Run

- a. File all documents in Room 219 (2nd floor) at the court house.
- b. In-Custody petitions must be filed before 11:00 a.m. If there are in-custody petitions included in the pile and there is a line at the "Criminal" window, wait for a break and let the court clerk know that you have in-custody petitions and file according to instructions in 2.c.ii.
- c. File petitions
 - i. At the "Criminal" window, let the court clerk know you have in-custody petitions (if any and if you didn't hand them in earlier).
 - ii. The Petitions will be "Received" stamped (they need a Judge's signature) by the clerk. The clerk will keep all copies except one Probation copy which you will retrieve and bring back for the department files.
- d. File Reports
 - i. The reports will be "Filed" stamped. The court clerk will only take the original (Judge's) copy and return the remaining copies (Probation, DA, and Attorney.
 - The probation copies of the reports that were originally in the Department 1 or 2 folders must be returned to their original folder.

- ii. Distribute the DA's and Attorney's copies in the appropriate will-call folders. Bring back the Probation copy for the department files.
- e. Collect paperwork from Probation's will-call folder
- f. Put any petition copies as well as any paperwork in the folder
- g. Return the Court Run

 - a. Place Received stamped petition on tab 4 (on the prong across from the Pinks) inside the file.
 - If there is a future court date, write that date in pencil on the front of the file and put it in the respective mailbox (Department 1 or Department 2).
 - c. If there is no future court date, file in the Open filing.

2. Reports

- a. Place filed report (Pre-sentence Investigation report, Supplemental report, memorandum) directly under the pinks with half sheet on top.
- b. If there is a future court date, write that date in pencil on the front of the file and put it in the respective mailbox (Department 1 or Department 2).
- c. If there is no future court date, file in the Open filing.
- iii. If the file is not in the area by the copier, do the following:
 - 1. Look for the file in Open files. If located, do the following:
 - a. Petitions
 - Place Received stamped petition on tab 4 (on the prong across from the Pinks) inside the file and file back in the open filing if there is no future court date.
 - If there is a future court date, write that date in pencil on the front of the file and put it in the respective mailbox (Department 1 or Department 2).

b. Reports

- Place filed report (Pre-sentence Investigation report, Supplemental report, memorandum) directly under the pinks with half sheet on top and file back in the open filing if there is no future court date.
- ii. If there is a future court date, write that date in pencil on the front of the file and put it in the respective mailbox (Department 1 or Department 2).

- 2. If the petition or report has a future court date and the file is not in Open, put it in the respective mailbox (Department 1 or Department 2).
- iv. Place any yellow or pink copies granting DEJ (Deferred Entry of Judgment) into the mailbox of the clerk processing DEJ file set-ups.
- v. Place 1203.9 petitions in the mailbox of the clerk processing 1203.9 file set-ups.
- vi. Place Far Northern Regional Center reports in the mailbox of the clerk processing the Dual Diversion set-ups.
- vii. Give any medical reports and other miscellaneous paperwork to the Supervising Clerk.

SETTING UP A FILE FOR ADULT FORMAL PROBATION

OVERVIEW

When a defendant is sentenced to Formal Probation, the court clerks will enter the PRF (ADL FORM PRB GRANT) event on the Court side. Following this, the defendant needs to be set up on the Probation Side to begin supervision. This process it important because it informs the supervision officer of the new case which ensures offenders begin getting needed services sooner. In addition, this process informs law enforcement of the offender's supervision status.

PROCEDURE

- 1. Get the Event from the Court
 - a. From the Master Menu, Choose #4 "Transfer Case From Court"
 - b. Type PRF Enter
 - c. Select a name from the list and enter "I" (for Inquiry) to go into the case on the courtside.
 - d. Select 9 (View Case Documents).
 - e. If there is a J&S Document Listed, continue with setup based on the J&S. If there is not, use the PSI in file for entry.
 - f. Hit F12 twice to return to Event Select Screen
 - g. Enter X next to Defendant name and Enter twice
- 2. Print J&S (If no J&S skip to #3)
 - a. Shift F1 to transfer to Court Side
 - b. Enter 9 (View Case documents) Enter
 - c. Select J & S Document Enter
 - d. Print Document
 - e. F12 to return to Case Master Inquiry
- 3. Print PSI (only if no J&S)
 - a. If you have the file, the PSI can be found under the pinks.
 - b. If you don't have the file, From the Master Menu choose #9 Work with File Documents – enter
 - i. Select "Short Form PSI" or "Adl Sup Rot New Off" enter
 - ii. Report will open in Word and can either be viewed on the computer or printed.
- 4. Check Probation End Date
 - a. Enter 8 (View Printed Document)
 - b. Locate Probation End date as ordered by the judge and ensure it matches the J&S or PSI.
 - c. F12 twice to exit to File Master Update on Probation Side
- 5. Enter General File Information
 - a. Enter 1 (General File Information)
 - b. Referral Type Enter AF for Adult Felony

- c. Court Disposition Enter 001 for Adult Felony Probation
- d. P.O. Ensure this is a supervision officer (not an investigations officer)
 - i. If an investigations officer is still listed, give file to SPO who assigns caseloads following set up.
- e. Probation Term Enter number of years defendant is ordered to be on Probation
- f. Date Probation to Start Enter sentencing date
- g. Date Probation to End Enter the date for the number of years minus one day (example: 3 years from 6/23/2016 is 6/22/2019) Enter
- 6. Enter Program Information
 - a. If the J&S indicates restitution for the victim or reserved restitution as part of the court orders, enter the restitution in Program Information
 - i. From File Master Update select 2 (Program Information)
 - ii. F10 to enter additional Programs
 - iii. Enter RT in Program Type
 - iv. Enter PO in Agency
 - v. Enter Sentencing Date in Referred Date Enter
 - vi. F12 to exit
 - b. <u>INFORMATIONAL ONLY</u> The Probation Officer is responsible for entering any programs for offenders who must register with law enforcement (SZ Sex Offenders, RD Drug Offenders, RA Arsonists, HV HIV)
- 7. Verify Disposition of Charges
 - a. From File Master Update select 3 (Charge/Issue Information)
 - b. Verify a disposition code is entered for each charge.
 - If a disposition code is enter for all charges, F12 to return to File Master Update
 - ii. If a disposition code is not entered for a charge, note the charge number(s) missing disposition and refer to the courtside on the second screen
 - 1. From File Master Update Shift F1 to switch to courtside
 - 2. Select 3 (Charge Information)
 - 3. Locate Count number(s)

FORMAL PROBATION TERMINATIONS

OVERVIEW

When a defendant completes formal supervision, the defendant needs to be terminated from probation on the Probation Side to complete supervision. This process is important because it informs law enforcement of the offender's supervision status. Rules around how police officers can engage a citizen are different when the person is under probation's supervision. The liability related to civil rights is significant for all involved.

PROCEDURE

- 1. List Cleanup
 - a. From Master Menu Select#4 (Transfer Case from Court)
 - b. Enter TRM Enter
 - c. Delete Misdemeanor (alphabetical portion of case number ends with "M") and Traffic Cases (alphabetical portion of case number ends with "TR)
 - i. Enter D by name Enter once
 - d. Delete any Closed, Work Program Cases (alphabetical portion of case number ends with WP), MS Cases(alphabetical portion of case number ends with ADMS), and CP Cases (alphabetical portion of case number ends with ADCP)
 - i. On second JALAN session from Master Menu, Select #5 (Proceedings/File Update)
 - ii. Enter last and first name of offender Enter
 - iii. If the status is CL or the alphabetical portion of the case number ends with ADMS, ADCP, or WP, delete the case off the TRM wheel on the first JALAN session.
 - 1. Enter D by name Enter once
 - e. Check for events that don't create a new file
 - i. Enter X by each name, enter
 - 1. If a red line that reads "This event type does not create a new File" appears on the screen, enter to remove the name
 - 2. If the red line does not appear, F12
- 2. Process Termination

 - Check the termination sheet to ensure a supervisor or lead officer has signed.
 - b. Terminate Case
 - i. From Master Menu Select #4 (Transfer Case from Court)

 - v. If there are programs listed, check the "CC" column for completion codes. If a program referral does not have a completion code, print screen and request the assigned Probation Officer to complete it.

 - iii. F12 to return to File Master Update
 - iv. Enter #9 (Work with File Documents)

 - ii. Enter SR4 Event to cancel DOJ record (EXCEPT IF THE CASE TERMINATED IS IN THE ICOTS SECTION OF THE BLUE SHEET)
 - Locate Event with SRF NEW CASE TO DOJ in the Event Description
 - 2. On second screen ensure DOJ number includes a string of numbers beginning with an A.
 - a. From File Master Update Select #10 (Update Person Record)
 - b. Confirm number
 - 3. On first screen F10 to enter new event
 - 4. Enter SR4 (SRF PROB TERM to DOJ)
 - 5. Enter 1 (Clear SRF, no longer on active supervision) Enter twice
 - 6. F12 to return to File Master Update
 - iii. Verify DOJ Number has been deleted
 - 1. Select #10 (Update Person Record)
 - 2. Verify no entry is in DOJ Number Field
 - 3. F12 to return to File Master Update
 - Close all person alerts except officer safety, warrants or Prop 47 person alerts.

RETURN COURT CALENDAR

OVERVIEW

When the Court officer returns from Court, he/she will bring back the calendar, all files, and "pinks". These files and "pinks" must be returned to their appropriate location which must be documented for future reference.

PROCEDURE

- 1. Check in the "Pinks"
 - a. If a "Pink" has a ½ sheet on the front indicating the need for a report (PSI, Supplemental, AOP, 288, POST) give the "Pink" to the clerk that is responsible for processing referrals and write the initials of the clerk in red ink in the margin to the left of the defendant's name on the return calendar.
 - b. If the "Pink" includes a reference to DEJ, give the "Pink" to the clerk who is responsible for DEJ file set-ups and write the initials of the clerk in red ink in the margin to the left of the defendant's name on the return calendar.
 - c. If the "Pink" has a ½ sheet referral for "Credits" only, write the Investigations Supervising PO's initials in red ink in the margin to the left of the defendant's name on the return calendar. Route that Pink to that Supervising PO's inbox in his/her office.
 - d. If the "Pink" references a future court date within the month, write "FCD" in red ink in the margin to the left of the defendant's name on the return calendar. File that "Pink" in the Pinks folder labelled "Future Court Dates" on the calendar clerk's desk.
 - e. If the "Pink" references a future court date more than a month away, write a dash (-) in the margin to the left of the defendant's name in red ink on the return calendar. File it in the "Pinks" file cabinet in alphabetical order.
 - f. If the "Pink" references that the defendant was an "FTA" (Failure to Appear) and that a Bench Warrant was issued, write a dash (-) in red ink in the margin to the left of the defendant's name on the return calendar. File it in the "Pinks" file cabinet in alphabetical order.
- 2. Check in the files
 - a. Scan the court notes into JALAN case file
 - i. From the Master Menu #5 (Proceedings/File Update)
 - ii. Enter Defendants Name Enter
 - iii. Select the Master Case Enter
 - 1. If there is only one active case (AC listed under status), this case is the master case.

- 2. If there is more than one active case, locate the case with the Master Case Tickler
 - a. Select an active case (AC listed under status)
 - b. #6 (Tickler Information) Enter
 - c. If "Master Case" is listed in the Ticklers, this case is the Master Case. If "Master Case is not listed", repeat steps a-c until the master case is located.
 - d. F12
- iv. Scan the court notes
 - 1. F11 (Images)
 - 2. F10 "Activate Scanner"
 - 3. Enter a description for the new scanned image (i.e. "Court Notes 2/6/17)
 - 4. Insert all the pink court notes into the scanner Enter
- v. Delete any images for court notes from a previous court date
 - 1. Enter "D" next to the selected image Enter
 - 2. F2 to confirm
- b. Distribute Files
 - i. If a file has a ½ sheet on the front indicating the need for a report (PSI, Supplemental, AOP, 288, POST) give the file to the clerk that is responsible for processing referrals and write the initials of the clerk in red ink in the margin to the left of the defendant's name on the return calendar.
 - ii. If there is a reference to a future court date in the pink court notes, write the Court Date on the outside of the file in pencil and place in that future court date's shelf on the Calendar Wall. Write the future court date in red ink in the margin to the left of the defendant's name on the return calendar.
 - iii. If the defendant is on Active Probation (defendant's status in General File Data is AC and a Supervision P.O. is listed) and the court notes indicate that the defendant was an FTA (Failure to Appear) and a Bench Warrant was issued, write "FTA" in pencil on the front of the file and put it in the FTA section of the Calendar Wall. Write "FTA" in red ink in the margin to the left of the defendant's name on the return calendar.
 - iv. If the file is pending with an Investigations officer (the defendant's status in General File Data is PN and a supervision officer is listed) and the court notes indicate that the defendant was an FTA (Failure to Appear) and a Bench Warrant was issued change the P.O. number in JALAN to indicate Bench Warrant by:
 - 1. #23 Master Menu-Enter
 - 2. #5 "Proceedings/File Update
 - 3. Enter Defendants Name Enter
 - 4. #1 "General File Information Enter

- 5. Enter PO29I in the PO Field Enter
- 6. Write "INV/FTA" in pencil on the front of the file and file it in the Intake Bench Warrant section of the Calendar wall. Write "INV/FTA" in red ink in the margin to the left of the defendant's name on the return calendar.
- v. If the file is on Active Probation (defendant's status in General File Data is AC and a Supervision P.O. is listed) and there is a ½ sheet for a POST referral (defendant was sentenced to prison), give the file to the Probation Officer handling the case (for termination). Write that officer's initials in red ink in the margin to the left of the defendant's name on the return calendar.
- vi. If the file is a <u>Closed</u> case (defendant's status in General File Data is CL) and there is a reference to DEJ, give the file to the clerk handling DEJ and write the clerk's initials in red ink in the margin to the left of the defendant's name on the return calendar.
- vii. If the file is a <u>Closed</u> case (defendant's status in General File Data is CL) and there is no reference to DEJ and there is not a future court date, file it back in closed section of the file room and write "Closed" on the return calendar in red ink in the margin to the left of the defendant's name.
- viii. If the court notes reference "As Recommended" or "As Rec" and the sentence is for Formal Probation, give the file to the clerk responsible for formal setups and write the clerk's initials on the return calendar in red ink in the margin to the left of the defendant's name.
- ix. If the court notes reference "As Recommended" or "As Rec" and the sentence is for Mandatory Supervision
 - Determine if the case reference is already on Formal Probation
 - a. From Master Menu #5 (Proceedings/File Update)
 - b. Enter defendant's name ENTER
 - c. Select Active Case
 - d. If Sup-Type listed is "Adult Formal", #4 (Event Information) Enter
 - e. If "ADL FORM PRB GRANT" and "SRF NEW CASE TO DOJ" are listed in events, the file was set up for formal probation and is active.
 - If the case is on formal probation, return the file to the assigned Probation Officer to terminate the formal case and write the officers initials on the return calendar in red ink in the margin to the left of the defendant's name.

- 3. If the case is pending with an Investigations Officer (status in File Master Update is PN and an Investigations Officer is listed as the P.O.), put the file in the Open section of the file room. Write "Open" in red ink in the margin to the left of the defendant's name on the return calendar.
- x. If the file is <u>pending</u> (status in File Master Update is PN) and the sentence is for State Prison or CR&R, give the file to the clerk handing terminations and write their initials on the return calendar in red ink in the margin to the left of the defendant's name.
- 3. File the return calendar in the return calendar basket according to the month and retain for one year. Shred after one year.
