Dear John Doe,

The Shasta County Sheriff's Office is writing to you in accordance with the regulations outlined in California Penal Code 29810, which addresses the relinquishment of firearms by individuals who are prohibited from possessing guns. That State of California has indicated that you have not complied with the legal requirement to surrender your firearms, or you have not provided proof that you have properly relinquished your firearms.

The Shasta County Sheriff's Office is respectfully requesting that you provide documentation proving you surrendered your firearms to either an authorized firearm dealer, or authorized law enforcement agency. Action on your part is necessary to ensure compliance with the law. Please be advised that failure to relinquish the firearms as mandated by the law may result in criminal charges and penalties.

As previously mentioned, the State of California provided the Shasta County Sheriff's Office with information that you have either not relinquished your firearms or have not provided valid proof that you have relinquished your firearms. Section 29813 of the California Penal Code requires the Shasta County Sheriff's Office to contact individuals, living in our jurisdiction, who are prohibited from possessing firearms and have not relinquished their firearms or have not provided proof they have properly relinquished their firearms.

This letter serves as notification that you have "14 days" from the date of this notice to provide the Shasta County Sheriff's Office with documentation proving that you have legally relinquished your firearms.
