## DID YOU KNOW?



Millions of batteries are sold every year around the world, and all are considered hazardous waste in California.

## WHY RECYCLE YOUR BATTERIES?

- To keep harmful materials out of our landfill
- To keep people and property in our community safe
- To support sustainability and resource conservation
- To reduce fires



## LITHIUM-ION BATTERIES

Lithium-ion battery fires can burn for hours or even days. Please ...

- Do not leave them plugged in for longer than it takes to charge
- Keep devices at room temperature
- Do not store devices in locations with direct exposure to sunlight or in hot vehicles
- Always place clear tape over the +/- terminals before storing with another lithium-ion battery
